LAPTOP POLICY: You may use laptops during class only for class purposes. If you use your laptop for any other purpose, however briefly, you should indicate on the roll that you are absent from the class; failure to do so is a violation of the Honor Code. In addition, using a laptop for matters not directly related to class during the class period will subject you to a deduction of one point for each incident.

ASSIGNMENTS: Reading assignments include portions of the Supplement, which consists for the most part of Georgia statutes. References are to pages in the Supplement. When one page contains multiple statutes, you should be able to discern which ones relate to the material under consideration. You will note that many statutes are relevant to material in subsequent classes, although they may only be included in the assignment the first time they are relevant.

ATTENDANCE: I consider three absences excessive; students who accumulate more than four absences may be excluded from taking the exam.

GRADING: The grade will be based on the final exam, except that up to three points may be awarded for participation, or deducted for lack of preparation or excessive absences, and unlimited points may be deducted for violation of the Laptop Policy, *supra*.

EXAM: The exam will be open book. You may bring any books or papers. You may **not** bring a computer or any device with memory, except in compliance with the GSU College of Law laptop exam procedures.
