# Canon 37 – Confidences of a Client

- It is the duty of a lawyer to preserve his client confidences.
- This duty outlasts the lawyer's employment ...
- If a lawyer is accused by his client, he is not precluded from disclosing the truth in respect to the accusation.
- The announced intention of a client to commit a crime is not included within the confidences which he is bound to respect.
