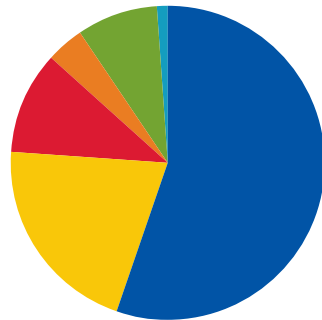


Class of 2014 Employment Data

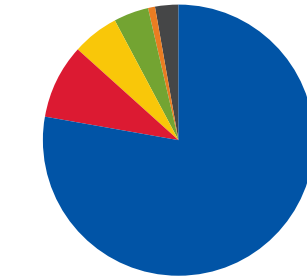
State bar passage rate for all first-time test takers: 84.5%
