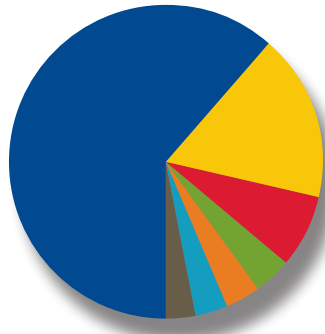


# Class of 2015 Employment Data

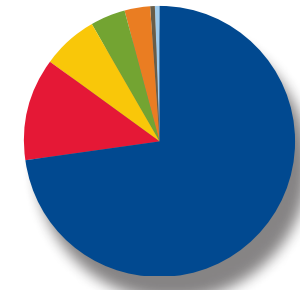
State bar passage rate for all first-time test takers: 73.5%
