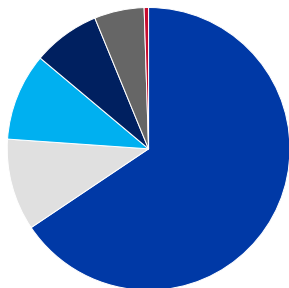


Class of 2022 Employment Data

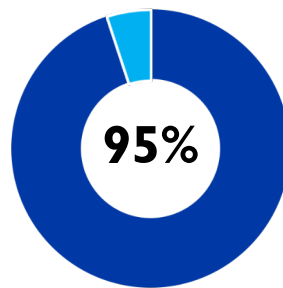

EMPLOYMENT TYPE PROFILE

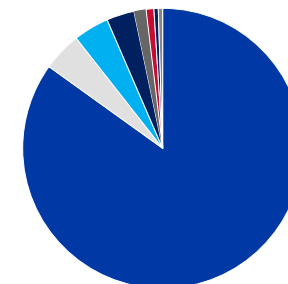
- Private Practice 65.6%
