Legal Services Organizations who would like to work with Georgia State Law students through the Pro Bono Program may submit the attached application by email to probono@gsu.edu. To be eligible for consideration:

- The project must be law-related
- Students may not receive compensation or academic credit
- The organization must provide supervision by a licensed attorney
- The project must serve people of limited financial means or charitable or not-for-profit organizations in matters designed primarily to address the needs of persons of limited financial means

If your project meets these requirements, submit the attached application. We will review the proposal, canvass students for availability and interest, and respond within two weeks. If this is an urgent project, make note of that in your email.
